N O T I F I C A T I O N Dated Peshawar, the 1st February, 2018

No.MWB/BK(76)/970.-In pursuance of recommendation of the Minimum Wages Board, the government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in exercise of powers under section-6 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Minimum Wages Act, 2013 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XII of 2013), is pleased to notify the rates of wages given in the schedule to be the minimum rates of wages, with effect from 1st January, 2018 for various categories of workers engaged in the brick kilns, whether registered or un-registered, in the Providce of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, with conditions / criteria laid down as under.

2. Subject to the conditions/criteria the following rates shall be applicable:-

- 4. The employers in the bricks kiln industry shall pay to their workers the wages at the rate not less than those given in the schedule.
- 5. The minimum wages and wages shall have the same meaning as assigned to it in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Minimum Wages Act, 2013.
- The provisions of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Factories Act, 2013 and other labour laws shall be applicable generally but particularly with regard to daily, weekly working hours, condition of overtime work, work on the days of rest and similar other ancillary matters.
- 7. The wages of apprentices shall be regulated in accordance with provisions of the Apprenticeship Ordinance, 1962 (as amended).
- 8.1 The employers shall revise, where necessary, the rates of remuneration for piece rated workers not specified in the schedule, so as to ensure that workers in such piece work occupations are enabled by working eight hours a day and 26 days in each month to earn not less than the corresponding minimum rates of monthly or daily wages as shown in the schedule.
- The recommended minimum rates of wages shall not be regarded as maximum rates and the existing wages higher than the given in the scheduled shall not be reduced. The employers shall, however, be free to pay higher wages either unilaterally on their own initiative or by collective agreements in view of any consideration including higher grade or skill or experience or higher cost of living in a particular locality or for any other reasons.
- The minimum rates of wages shall be applicable to time rated workers including temporary workers and piece rated workers and workers engaged on contract basis with effect from 1st January, 2018.
- 11. A female worker shall get the same minimum rates of wages given in the scheduled as a male worker for the work of equal value.
- 12. No discrimination shall be made on the basis of religion, political affiliation, sect, colour, caste, creed, ethnic background etc. with regard to payment of minimum wages fixed herein.
